

BAJ 2019 JERRY MOLOSKY SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

PURPOSE:

The JERRY MOLOSKY BORN AGAIN JOCK SCHOLARSHIP was established to assist Bloomington students who have the ability and desire to pursue an education beyond high school at a university, college, vocational/trade school or other accredited institution of higher learning.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Must be a legal resident of the State of Minnesota and a citizen of the United States.
- Must be in attendance at scholarship luncheon on Thursday May 16th, 2019 to receive award.
- Must be in his/her senior academic year as a student in the Bloomington Independent School District No. 271.
- Must have participated in high school varsity athletics.
- Must meet the academic standards of the school he/she attends and have a high school grade point average (GPA) of 3.0 or above (on a 4.0 point scale).
- Must have a good record of community involvement and other school activities. Community involvement are voluntary activities outside of school such as church, BAA coaching/involvement, Boy/Girl Scouts, food programs, etc.

BASIS OF SELECTION:

Scholarships will be awarded based on **athletic participation, community involvement (outside of school), family financial need, GPA and attached personal letter**. Award decisions will be made by the **BORN AGAIN JOCKS** scholarship award selection committee made up of members of the Born Again Jocks and the school activities directors and will be final.

EXTENT OF AWARD:

Each scholarship award is \$1500.00 and is for one year only. A check in the amount of the award will be issued to the student when verification of enrollment is received by the BAJs. Verification **MUST** be received by Sept. 1st, 2019.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE:

* All procedures must be followed to have application accepted.

1. Complete both sides of this application form in detail.
2. Submit one letter of recommendation from a school administrator, counselor, teacher or coach.
3. Submit a personal letter written by the applicant that must include relevant applicant information, reasons for applying, community involvement, stated financial need, educational goals and any other pertinent information the applicant believes would be helpful for the Scholarship Committee to consider and evaluate. Be very specific. Have the reference letter person sign your personal letter.

Application deadline is Tuesday April 2nd, 2019. Please submit Application to the Counseling Office/Career Center.
